GENERAL INFORMATION

- There is no late registration fee, but as a courtesy to the event planners please try and register by January 20, 2009.
- Cost **\$ 7.00** per Scout participant. Fee includes Scout participation patch, Troop participation ribbon, Patrol placement ribbons, prizes for top patrols, hot beverages, some of the program materials.
- Adults are free, but must register also.
- Adults wishing to purchase a participation patch may do so for **\$ 1.50** per patch.
- New this year the patches will be available the day of the Klondike derby. We are again having a patch design contest this year. The contest is open to all Scouts and Scouters. The patch design must include the following items in the design. Quinsigamond District, Klondike Derby, 2009, BSA or the BSA logo. The design must be submitted to Jeffrey Harris at the Council Service Center by the close of business on December 12, 2008. We reserve the right to make changes to the design for clarification purposes or other reasons.
- The tradition of offering free coffee and hot cocoa to everyone will continue.
- Reminder to all, DO NOT bring firewood into camp.
- All patrols should plan on bringing/making their own lunch.
- New this year, for those who may want something in addition to their own lunch, there will be some refreshments for sale at the West Lodge.
- All Troops should bring 2 rosters with them. Pass one in at the Magee Center and the other at the West Lodge.
- As a whole the Klondike Derby is not a timed event but there may be timed elements of various stations.
- Various Klondike Derby sled plans are available on the internet. We would like all patrols to participate with a sled but it is not mandatory.
- To earn the maximum allowable points at the Derby all patrols/troops should participate in all the scheduled events, bring all requested materials, follow all rules and preregister.
- Each participating patrol should bring the following items with them to the Klondike Derby. Klondike Derby sled, paper, pencils, Scout Handbook, 2 compasses, 2 large Ziploc style bags, trash bag, proper clothing for all participants, 1 blindfold for each participant, 3 plastic grocery bags, 288 ounces of water (in addition to your drinking water), lunch for each participant, pot/pan with at least a 32 ounce capacity, 1 banana, at least 36 square feet of plastic or tarp, 1 canned food item per participant, 1 drinking straw per participant, patrol flag, any diameter rope (at least 50' per patrol, can be in several pieces), matches, 1 nine volt battery, 1 paperclip, and a list of the first names and current rank of the patrol members.
- If the Klondike derby needs to be cancelled due to severe weather the information will be on WTAG am580.
