#### Aquatics:

## Programs Available During Off Season Camping

Camping facilities can be rented on a year round schedule with a variety of activities available in the fall, winter and spring seasons. These facilities include:

- -> standard campsites with platforms for tents / latrines
- -> Rustic campsites for tents / latrines
- -> Lean-to sites with electricity / latrines (16-32 people sites)
- -> Family Cabins—four heated cabins with room for 8 people per cabin, 32 person picnic shelter nearby/ latrine
- —> Memorial Lodge—heated, kitchenette, room for 10 inside and 4 more outside in a lean-to.
- —> Eagle Lodge—heated, showers, bathrooms, kitchenette, large bunk room with 14 beds and 6 individual rooms with 3 beds each. Sleeps 32 people.
